



Investigation Report: Influence of ELUUMIS Biohealing Stream Exposure on Sunflower Seed Germination

Date: July 30 – August 6, 2025

Researcher: ELUUMIS; Biohealing stream; Debbie Hagedorn (Independend investigator)

Objective

To examine the effects of **ELUUMIS energy** exposure via Eluumis Sky device and via **Biohealing Stream** on sunflower seed germination and early development, compared to a control group watered with untreated well water without any exposure

Materials & Setup

- **Date Initiated:** July 30, 2025
 - **Containers:**
 - (2) containers with well water (tested by researcher)
 - (1) container of well water charged with *ELUUMIS Sky* for 2 hours
 - **Trays:**
 1. Control
 2. Eluumis
 3. Stream
 - **Seeds:** 1/4 cup of shallow-planted sunflower seeds per tray
 - **Watering:**
 - Trays 1 & 3: well water
 - Tray 2: Eluumis-charged well water for 2 hours
 - **Environment:** Trays kept indoors for consistent germination temperature and covered for darkness. Seeds were **not pre-soaked** before planting.
 - **Laptop** for running Stream Sessions
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Initial Treatment (July 30, PM)

Living Room:

- **Living room:** Eluumis exposure – 30 min exposure ELUUMIS SKY
- **Kitchen:** Stream exposure – 30 min exposure Biohealing stream
- **Bedroom:** Control – no exposure



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All trays were covered for darkness between treatments.

Observations Summary

- **Germination:** At August 2. Control group showing most growth. Eluumis tray showing least sprouting

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- **Growth Consistency (as of Aug 6):**

- Control: Consistently shortest
 - Stream: Less consistently, half/half. The tallest were exposed to Biohealing Stream Energy
 - Eluumis: Consistently tallest
- **Environmental Note:** Trays spent the day outside on Aug 6, returned indoors overnight.

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Results & Discussion

Exposure to **Eluumis biophotonic energy** produced a clear enhancement in germination rate and overall growth vigor compared to the control group. Seeds irradiated by the **Biohealing Stream** also showed improvement over the control, though to a lesser degree. The strongest results were observed on the side directly exposed to the Biohealing stream emission.

Observations suggest that **biophotonic irradiation** from the Eluumis device and Biohealing stream may accelerate **metabolic activation within seeds**, stimulating early sprout emergence and promoting greater developmental uniformity.

A slight delay in initial germination within the Eluumis and Biohealing Stream trays indicates the formation of **stronger root systems**, as embryos first utilized stored nutrients to establish robust foundational growth before rapid vertical development.

This experiment was conducted **independently by an external expert** over a continuous **7-day observation period**, under identical environmental and handling conditions across all three test groups.

Even beyond the experimental timeframe, seedlings from the **Eluumis** and **Biohealing Stream** trays maintained visibly superior vitality compared to the control — characterized by **faster germination, stronger root formation, and more vigorous overall growth**.

Preliminary Conclusion

Exposure to **Eluumis biophotonic energy** and **Biohealing Stream irradiation** demonstrated a measurable positive influence on seed germination and early sprout development compared to untreated controls.

The findings suggest that ELUUMIS biophotonic energy:

- **enhance metabolic activation**
- **stronger root establishment,**
- **uniform growth patterns.**
- Promote strong root system for plants
- Support stronger overall growth and alignment within the germination phase
